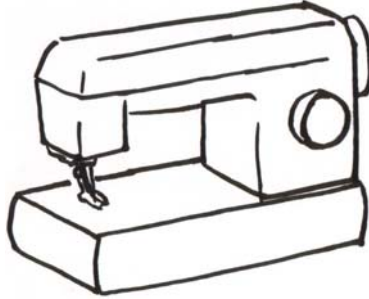

Kids' Sewing In the sewing classes, the students age eight and older start by making a basic tote bag and then progress to a project of his/her own choice. The students will be taught by certified instructors how to thread and operate a sewing machine, and the skills necessary to complete a sewing project.

*There is a \$12 registration fee for new students, which includes the materials necessary to make the draw-string tote.
